Toshiba:

The typical next steps would be either an on-campus interview or an interview on-site at our facility. If you don't hear directly from the recruiter feel free to go ahead and email them, call them, touch base and find out what you need to do to be able to get that interview, whether it's on-campus, on-site or be able to make it to the next step.

Montsano:

We typically, at LSU Career Expos, we select a number of résumés. We may make some notes as we go through the Career Expo day. We'll go through and review those notes. We review all the résumés that we have on file. We actually, for Montsano, we ship those to our corporate office. It has all of our HR resources. From there, we'll go ahead and contact the particularly strong candidates that we have, and more forward with either phone screening or in some cases an on-site interview.

PROSYS:

They should always get a business card to where they can email and find out if we are hiring or if we had a chance to look over their application. And they can also, depending on what the company says they should do, they can also give a call.

PhilipMorrisUSA:

Some great advice from me (I just got out of college a couple years ago) follow up with them don't wait for them to follow up with you. If you show interest in the company, it helps us out a lot.
