Residential Life is on Facebook and Twitter!

Residential Life (ResLife) is now on two of the new social media sites, Facebook and Twitter! The LSU ResLife Facebook site is a great way to learn about the many activities, programs and events going on within ResLife. You don't have to be a member, just go to our website homepage, and in the lower right corner, click on the Facebook button. It looks like this:



If you are a Facebook member, just sign on and search for LSU ResLife. See pictures from the snow day, the RHA crawfish boil, watch videos, and learn about the newest residential college. It's fun and informative and a bit less formal than our official website.

You can also receive updates and messages about ResLife by "following" the LSU Student Life Twitter account - @lsustudents! You do have to join Twitter to receive messages, but it is free. Just go to Twitter.com and follow the simple instructions to join. Then do a search for *lsustudents* and it will bring up the Student Life account. The picture for our account is Mike the Tiger; it looks like this:



Click on the picture of Mike and you will see all of the ResLife and Student Life messages. Right below the picture box, click on the "follow" button and you will receive all the ResLife and LSU Student Life messages to your account.

Messages sent in Twitter are called Tweets, and they are very short. Tweets can only be 140 characters or less. The Tweets can be about anything, but often answer the signature Twitter question, "What are you doing?" Learn about fun facts, send and receive links to great articles, videos and websites, or learn what important events are coming up within ResLife and other Student Life organizations. You can search for your friends and students and "follow" them. Once you get the hang of things, you can start sending Tweets so your friends and students can "follow" you.
